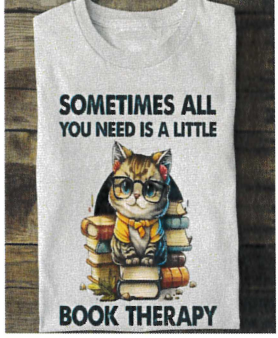

Why people came to church:

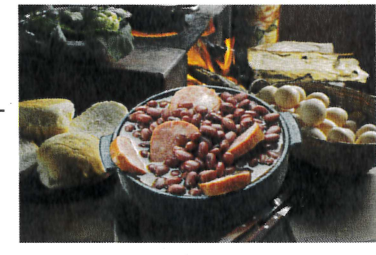
- 6-8% Came by own initiative

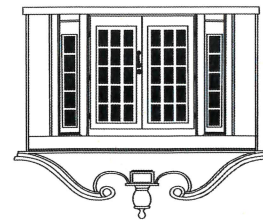
