The past few weeks have felt like a whirlwind of headlines, with a mix of tariffs, ceasefires, spending freezes, peace deals, and much more. The constant flood of information from countless sources can feel overwhelming, even paralyzing. While this is hardly unusual in our modern world, I would like to offer a few words of encouragement to help you navigate it effectively.

1. Pray and stay in the Word.

There is no substitute for prayer and Scripture when it comes to preparing and anchoring our hearts in Truth. Each day brings challenges, distractions, and uncertainties, but we have access to the One who reigns over all. Speak to the Lord who sits enthroned above it all, and listen to His voice through His Word. Today—not tomorrow—is the best day to be rooted in the Word. As Jesus reminded us, "Tomorrow will worry about itself" (Matthew 6:34). 2. See those made in God's image.




