The Ascension of Christ

Now when He had spoken these things, while they looked, He was taken

up. And a cloud received Him from their sight. — Acts 1:9

When the Lord Jesus Christ had finished His redemptive work on this earth—when the cross had been endured, the tomb conquered, and salvation secured—He ascended in majesty to the right hand of the Father. Friend, the **Ascension** is not just a moment in time; it is the **coronation of the King of kings!** The Lamb who was slain is now the Lion who reigns!

The same Jesus who was mocked by men and misunderstood by the multitudes—He who was "despised and rejected," a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief—now sits enthroned in glory, crowned with honor, and worshiped by the hosts of heaven. The jeers of the crowd have given way to the songs of seraphim. The cracking of whips and the clang of nails have been silenced by the sound of heaven's hallelujahs and the flourish of celestial trumpets.

Jesus Christ is not hanging on a cross today—He is seated in victory at the right hand of God the Father. And the Bible says He will sit there "until His enemies are made His footstool" (Hebrews 10:13). Every scoffer, every skeptic, every rebel power will bow before Him. Every crown will be cast at His feet.

And one day—oh yes, one glorious day—this same Jesus shall return. But not as He came the first time... not in meekness riding on a donkey, but in power and great glory, riding on the clouds of heaven, with a name above every name!

So we do not merely remember the Ascension—we rejoice in it. For the King has ascended... and the King is coming again.
