# 2025 Advent and Christmas at Levy Baptist Church



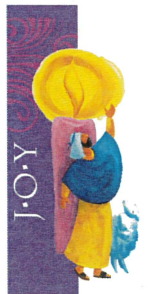
Dear Church Family,

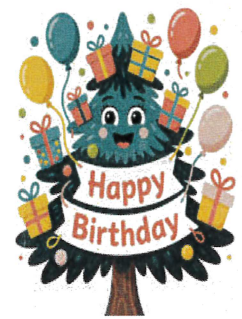

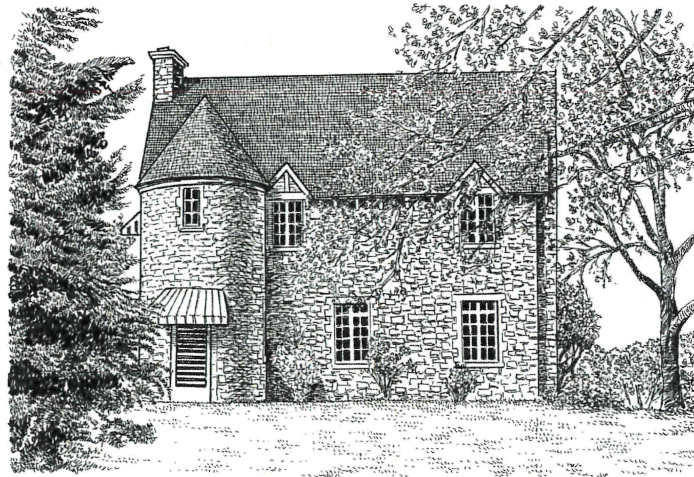
