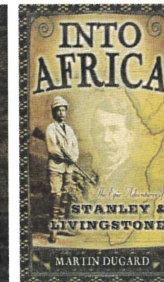
Sunday, July 19

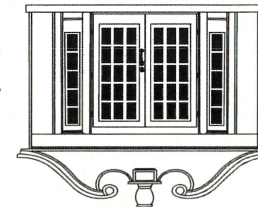
